





INSTALL

Yay! Its time to install! Here's a few hints to help you get ready for the main event.

TOOLS YOU WILL NEED


Zip tie




Twine



Wire




Scissors



Nippers



Rope



Ladders

1. Put music on your boom-box

2. Plan The space. Start by unloading the streams*. Lay them out in the space on the ground to gauge where they will need to be hung. It can take some time to complete an install, plan on at least 3 - 5 hours.

Things to watch out for:

Exit sighs


Hot lights

Fire related anything

Fans

3. Get out your ladders, and start hanging. Streaming can be hung using zip ties, twine, rope to most any ceiling and/or wall. Although the streamers are light be sure to have enough attachment points so that they will not fall during your event.

4. Use the available tabs for easy end attachment points:



Attach through grid in middle sections:


5. Take pictures! These things look awesome going up, have fun, post your pictures, we love to see what you have done.

PANEL



Panels range in length from 12' - 13'. they can be very affective back drops on either the stream side or the grid side, for a more graphic look. Try adding a tuck or wave to give dimension to the wall.








Indoor/ Outdoor


Hang low with a plastic liner

with this option




CANOPY



Good for skylights, entryways, over a special area, great for creating shade.

Hang canopy from the four corners with the rope that is strung. The canopy has rope strung along the length of all sides of the canopy to provide support. If attaching in the middle of the canopy, be sure to attach around the rope.



DEINSTALL

It's time to take down the fun. Hope the event was amazing! Follow these simple steps for the EZest clean up. There will be shedding involved in the deinstall, this is normal.

1. Cut down the panels/swags. (Please refrain from cutting the streams) Things come down a lot faster then they go up. Plan on at least 1 1/2 hours for take down.

2. Roll up Swags. Roll swags with the streams coming out on one end.




Swags and baskets go in zippered bags.


2 swags

PLEASE DO NOT CUT GRID



3. Roll panels. Lay tarps on ground that is free of debris. Lay panels in the middle of the tarp, layer 2 panels on top of each other, fold sides of tarp over panels, and roll up like a burrito.



Bungee the ends of the roll , and wa-la you have packed your roll

4. Pack your baskets. Stack the baskets on top of each other, pack them 5 deep and put them into zippered bag.

And now your DONE!!
